Dear Mathxwí Families,

As you are aware, on September 21, Stó:lo Nation, confirmed at least 158 children deaths at four locations, including St. Mary's Residential School in Mission. This information is incredibly heartbreaking and is also the lived experience of what Elders have been saying for generations. In solidarity with all school districts in the Fraser Valley, we have lowered our flag to half-mast through to the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation, to hounour the many children who did not return home from these institutions, and to those and the families who endured the atrocities of Residential Schools and continue to be impacted. ## **Orange Shirt Day**

In 2013 press conference, Phyllis (Jack) Webstad, a Residential School Survivor from Stswecem'c Xget'tem First Nation, shared her personal and traumatic experience at a Residential School. One of her memories was from her first day at St. Joseph's Mission Residential School near Williams Lake. Phyllis wore her brand new orange shirt that her Grandma bought for her. She wasn't allowed to wear her own clothes at school. As soon as she arrived, the orange shirt was taken away from her and never returned. To Phyllis, the colour orange has always symbolized that she did not matter. Today, with her efforts

with the Orange Shirt Society, the orange shirt has become a symbol of Hope and Reconciliation that spreads the



message that Every Child Matters. Mathxwi Elementary will be honouring Indigenous residential school survivors by wearing orange to school on Thursday, September 28<sup>th</sup>.
