
### PAC Pizza Day!

## Parent Teacher Conferences (early dismissal)

On Wednesday October 19<sup>th</sup> and Thursday October 20<sup>th</sup>, school will be dismissed at 12:30pm. You will be receiving an email this week to book an interview time with your child's teacher.

As a staff we have set our goal for this year to be the following:

"If we are intentional about making our school a place of hope, healing and wellness where personal and cultural identity are honoured and celebrated, will our students reading scores show marked improvement by June 2023?"

In our striving toward that end we have shaped our October Parent-Teacher conferences to take on a different format this year. We believe that as parents you have a unique and valuable perspective on who your child is, the values you hold as a family, and strengths and growth areas that will contribute to your child's educational success. Our aim for these interviews is to gain a deeper understanding from both parents and students so that we, as teachers, are able to help build meaningful, lasting connections between our students and their learning.

Here are a few example questions that we may ask during the interviews:

- 1. What makes you (your child) a great kid?
- 2. What is your (your child's) two greatest strengths?
- 3. What are two areas that you (your child) need help in? How can we support you (your child) in these areas?
- 4. What is your/your child's favourite way to learn?
- 5. Tell me about a time when you (your child) learned/accomplished something you (they) were really proud of? What made it wonderful? What could be done to have more of those moments?
- 6. Tell me about a time when someone showed that they cared about you (your child)? What did they do or say that helped you (your child) feel cared for?
