We're excited to share that Máthxwi Elementary has once again taken the hassle out of back-to-school shopping! All school supplies for the 2025–26 school year have already been purchased and sorted for every student. Thanks to bulk purchasing and the incredible effort of our teachers—who personally sorted the supplies—we were able to keep costs low and ensure everything is ready to go. Supplies will be handed out by your child's teacher during the first week of school.

#### What do you need to do?

Please pay through **SchoolCash Online**, price point will be between \$45-\$60 depending on the grade. This will be available to pay in September. Your child will be all set for the year! And don't forget to give a big **thank you** to our amazing staff for making this possible.

**4. Kindergarten Gradual Entry:** To help parents plan for the first two weeks, here is some information about how things will unfold. Tuesday, September 2<sup>nd</sup> will start with a parent meeting at 9:15 in the library. Yes, your child can attend but we will be speaking to the adults about what to expect. Then, **September 2nd and 3rd are dedicated to 15-minute interviews.** This is a wonderful opportunity for us to meet each other in the Kindergarten classroom. This is time for your child to come into the classroom with the comfort of a parent to visit and meet the teachers.

From **September 4th** - **September 12th** students are invited to a variety of **Gradual Entry Small Group Sessions** where they will work with their classmates. This enables us to introduce beginning routines in a smaller setting and provide more individualized attention. We ask that your child attend school during the times marked with their group on the calendar below. Please drop off and pick up your child at the exterior door of the school, Room 121.

Kindergarten gradual entry schedules will be sent home at the end of August directly to new Kindergarten families. We are currently finalizing a few details. Stay tuned for more information.
